SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

First Holy Reconciliation & Holy Communion

1st Reconciliation and 1st Holy communion programme for 2018 will commence in Oct 2107 for children in year 3 and above. Registration forms can be obtained from the Parish Office or in the Narthex in both Churches. Completed forms must be returned to Fr Joe or Deacon Paul by Sept 17, 2017.

Sacrament of Confirmation
