Update on Parish Projects

You would remember that about few years ago, we began a consultation with you on how we might improve on facilities in our two Churches. There were presentations, including drawings and cost estimates for safeguarding / health and safety improvements at St Wulstan's and OLG. That consultation and the architect's responses were all put on hold while the Diocese announced its study on the future all the property it owned which, of course included our two Churches.

Projects which were authorised and implemented included:

- Cushions for the pews at St Wulstan's
- The renewal of the windows and toilets at OLG and
- The improved sound system at OLG and St Wulstan's.

About a year ago we got the Bishop's confirmation that BJHN's properties were secure for the foreseeable future. On that basis I have asked a small group to restart the study of what might be done working with the diocesan architect. We also have a clearer picture of what funds might be available. In the last two years some fresh ideas have been put into the mix and I anticipate that soon we shall have some fresh images and proposals for projects which will include:

- Improvements for admin spaces and priest's accommodation
- Proposals for the community space at St Wulstan's and
- Compliance work at both churches – especially lighting and electrics among other works.

I felt it right to make this brief update so that the next consultation doesn't come as a complete surprise. I was personally pleased to get the assurance from the diocese that we are here to stay for the foreseeable future. Thank you for your continued support. Fr Joe
