So what is this

GOOD NEWS?

Read on - it could be the best read of your life!!!

1. God loves us just the way we are.

2. Our sins and failings stop us experiencing that love.

Did you know that God loves you, really loves you, like not even the closest human relation or friend ever has or ever could? He loves you because He made you. He knows you intimately – better than you know yourself!

HE LOVES YOU JUST AS YOU ARE.

All of us sin. Most of the time we don't want to, but we still find ourselves doing things that we know we shouldn't, and not doing things we know we should. It's something we inherited from our parents, who got it from their parents, who got it from theirs.... because, way back in the beginning, our first parents chose to reject God's way and tried to do it their own way. We are still the same today. God, though, still loves us, but our sins separate us from Him and stop us experiencing His love. It's not that God wants to control us – as our loving Creator, He wants the best for us!

3. We all need a Saviour..... **WE HAVE ONE.** His name is Jesus. He died for **YOU** and rose again to give you new life!

We need a Saviour – someone who is bigger and stronger than we are; someone who has lived this earthly struggle and knows just what it is like, but who didn't sin. Someone who can re-connect us to God...

This someone was born on earth 2000 years ago. His name is Jesus, and He claimed to be the Son of God. He died on a cross to prove His love for you and then, three days later, rose again to set you free from sin and the fear of death, proving He was who He said He was.

4. **HE** is inviting **YOU** today to follow Him!

Jesus invites you today, and every day, to believe in Him; to make a decision to stop living life your way and follow His way of true freedom instead; to invite Him into your heart so He can show you a new way of living in true freedom!

5. **HE** will give you the help and power of His Holy Spirit!

If you will do this, if you will invite Him to be your Saviour, Lord and the best friend you'll ever have, you will receive the power of His Spirit to help you.....

6. Jesus invites you to be a part of His family, the Church.

Without the help of brothers and sisters who are walking the way of Jesus it is impossible to make progress in the Christian life – we need God's help and the help of others, and we find this in His Church – and yes, His followers often fail, but, by trusting Him, by the help of His love, they are able to journey on towards our home in heaven....

7. Jesus invites you to read His word each day for the next week, to ponder on it, and to invite Him to reveal Himself to you through that word.

To help you do this, first find a comfortable, quiet place to sit. Then relax and try to forget anything that may distract you. Say a simple prayer, such as 'Come Holy Spirit, help me to understand what you want to say to me through this Scripture'. Read the Scripture once and note if any particular word or phrase speaks to you. Read the Scripture again, slowly. Ask God to speak to you personally through it. Read it once more and pray the **prayer response** which comes after the scripture passage. Now, finally, sit in silence for a few minutes and let God speak to your heart.
